A Message From The President

All of these questions are inter-related and impactful on the economics of your operational equation. What is unique about EJOA is we have brought many of the providers and businesses that operate in these areas to one place where you can engage them, ask questions, and collect information to make the best decisions for you and your family or business.

Embraer as the aircraft OEM, Pratt & Whitney and Honeywell as the engine OEMs, JSSI as the largest independent provider of engine/APU programs, recurrent training providers Flight Safety and CAE as well as a host of other support organizations are all here. Spending a few minutes engaged in the right discussion with each of these suppliers could wind up saving you a lot of grief, perhaps some cash, too, and maybe even make the difference in how you handle a difficult situation while flying your aircraft.

Kevin LaRosa II is a third-generation pilot and second-generation aerial coordinator and stunt pilot. Known for his work on major blockbusters like *The Avengers* (2012), *Iron Man* (2005) and *Transformers: The Last Knight* (2017), Kevin LaRosa II has worked on over 100 different motion picture and commercial productions.

Kevin's father, Kevin LaRosa Sr, began taking him on movie shoots at the early age of 10 and by age 17, Kevin received his pilot's certificate. He started logging flight time at the early age of 14 and accumulated his ratings as quickly as he could. By the time he was 18, Kevin was a commercially rated helicopter and multi-engine fixed wing pilot logging time in everything from King Airs to Hueys.

Today, Kevin is one of Hollywood's most sought-after pilot and aerial coordinators, licensed to fly a variety of aircraft ranging from helicopters and airplanes to Learjets and more. Kevin is an ATP rated pilot trained and certified in a multitude of aircraft. He also holds type ratings in several Learjet models and the **Phenom 300** in addition to the C-130/ L-382 Hercules and the Sikorsky S-70/ UH-60, as well as an FAA Part 107 UAS rating for flying unmanned aircraft. Kevin is a member of the Screen Actors Guild, and the Motion Picture Pilots Association. His latest work can be seen in Paramount's record-breaking blockbuster, **Top Gun: Maverick**. Ron Mumm is passionate about aviation. His story is one of pursuing that passion with commitment, determination and many amazing relationships. His background in high performance jet aviation is extensive.

For nearly 25 years, Ron led Business Aviation operations for High-Net Worth Individuals, Family Offices, and Fortune 50 Corporations. He recently retired as the Director of Aviation for Reyes Holdings, one of the largest privately-held US companies.

His distinguished aviation background also includes a 20-year Air Force career as an F-15 and F-16 fighter pilot, operational test pilot, instructor pilot, and Thunderbird pilot. He is a graduate of the prestigious USAF Fighter Weapons School. He is type-rated with broad flight experience in Bombardier, Cessna, Dassault, and Gulfstream aircraft. He has flown to most corners of the world accumulating over 10,000 hours. He still actively flies a Cirrus SR22, and was previously, and proudly, an SR22 owner.

Born in Birmingham, Alabama, he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Aviation Management from Auburn University. He later earned a Masters degree in Business Administration from Troy University. Always entrepreneurial, Ron led several business ventures during his school years. That life experience and those experiences gained in the Air Force provided an extensive background in high performance teams...and led to his selection to the Air Force's highest performing team—the Thunderbirds.

Ron was selected as Thunderbird #1, where he commanded the US Air Force Thunderbird team, and flew as the lead pilot in every demonstration. He performed before more than 20 million people in the USA, Canada, the Pacific, and in Europe.

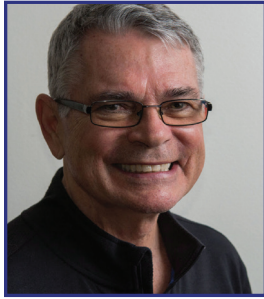
Ron's ability to inspire teamwork from others continues with his charitable involvement with the Make-a-Wish Foundation, the United Way, the March of Dimes, and the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention. He has served on the National Board of Advisors for the Museum of Aviation, the Thunderbird Senior Advisory Board, and the Flight Safety Foundation's Corporate Advisory Committee. He is a fervent aviation advocate and mentor.

Ron also is a frequently requested motivational speaker and lights the afterburners with his energy. When he speaks, he speaks from the heart with warmth, humor, and a southern charm. His unique gift is real-life stories with a fast paced, high-risk backdrop that will touch the audience's heart, mind, and soul. Colleagues have recognized his special qualities with numerous awards for leadership, patriotism, and humanitarian causes. The Air Force awarded him the Distinguished Flying Cross.

Ron is married to Heidi (40 years), has a son (37), a daughter (35), and 6 grandchildren.

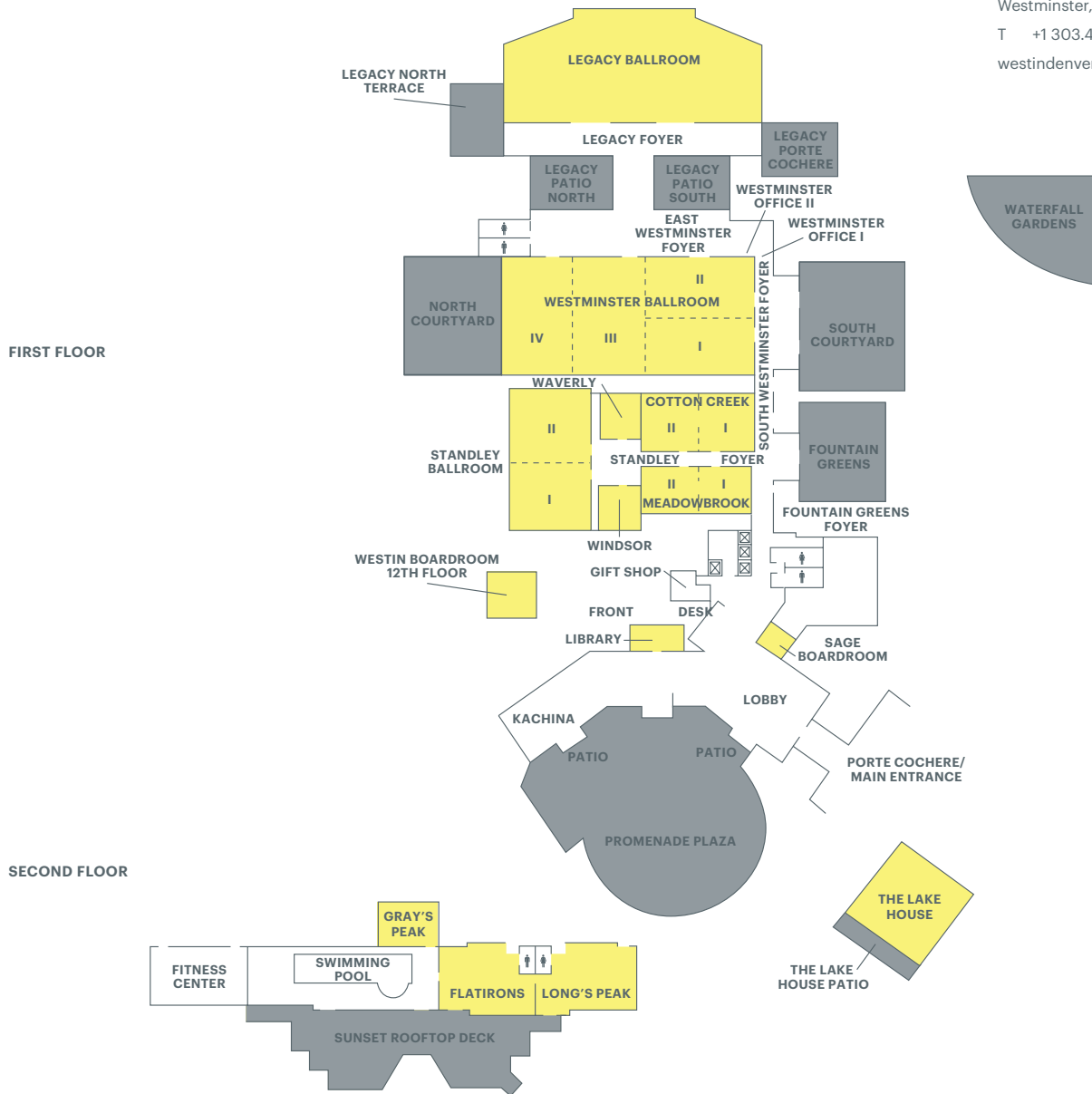

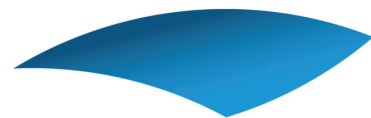
